- REQUIREMENTS You must be a foreign national residing in Kagoshima Prefecture, and have not previously received the Grand Prize in this contest.
- MAX APPLICANTS 40 people (only individual applications are accepted.) Please make sure to send all required documentation by 1st December, as we may have to screen applicants in the case of a large number of applications. We will inform you whether or not the screening process with take place, as well as the result of your application, regardless of its outcome.
- THEME Anything except for <u>RELIGION</u> or <u>POLITICS</u>.
- TIME LENGTH 4 6 minutes.
- AWARDS Grand Prize (¥50,000 and an extra prize); Honorable Mention Award, Judges' Special Award; etc.
- DEADLINE 22nd November 2020
- APPLICATIONS Complete all required components of the application form and send it via fax, email, post, or you can also deliver in person.

• OTHER The use of props is not permitted.

ENTRY & SEATING

Preliminary Round: Entrance to the Preliminary Round is restricted to applicants, their family/or accompanied guardian/friend, judges and news/radio crews.
Contest: 190 seats available. (Applicants, Judges and VIP are already accounted for) More information on seating will be available at a later date.

MASK WEARING

Everyone must wear a mask at all times.

However, once an applicant is isolated on the stage in preparations for their speech, the mask may be removed.

PREVENTION THROUGH STERILISATION

Each time a speech finishes, <u>we will be disinfecting the microphone</u> and the surrounding area.

Those entering the auditorium will have their temperatures checked and must cleanse their hands in alcoholic disinfectant before entering.
